Our Y12 Fine Artists, Graphic Designers and Photographers are currently learning the skills required to be successful when producing independent work in Y13. These include traditional manual skills and digital editing techniques. They also learn traditional darkroom techniques, ceramics using a pottery wheel and studio lighting. These skills will enable them to become effective visual storytellers.

Our Y12 vocational Art & Design students (UAL) are currently studying a wide range of fine art & digital art skills in order to become more fully developed art practitioners. These skills include Architecture, Ceramics, Fine Art, Graphic Communication, Photography and Textiles. The Y13 students complete personal projects using their own chosen specialism. The outcomes are highly personal and individual artworks.

Our Y13 students are engaged in projects using a range of skills to produce highly individual and independent works on topics which include, amongst others, feminism, mental health, environmental issues, family history and identity & gender. The outcomes range from photo essays to exhibited works, product design to game design, packaging design to building design and large scale artworks.
